

# Parent Communication Guide for AI Education

## 1. Why Parents Need to Be Informed

Some parents may have concerns about AI in education — privacy worries, fear of misuse, or simply not understanding what AI means. Clear, positive communication builds trust and can turn parents into supporters.

## 2. Common Parent Questions & How to Answer Them

Parent Question	Your Response
Will AI do homework for my child?	We teach students to use AI as a tool, not a shortcut — like a calculator.
Is my child's data safe?	We only use privacy-compliant tools and never share student data.
Will my child still learn to think?	AI literacy enhances critical thinking — students learn to question AI, not just use it.
I don't understand AI — how can I help?	Ask your child to teach you! It reinforces their learning.
Is this replacing teachers?	AI assists teachers — it cannot replace human connection and mentoring.

10–25 min	Live demo: Show Teachable Machine — parents build their own mini-model
25–40 min	Q&A: Open questions from parents
40–55 min	How parents can support AI learning at home
55–60 min	Resources to share: free websites, our training guides

## 4. How Parents Can Support AI Learning at Home

- Ask "What did you build in AI class today?" and listen with curiosity.
- Try one AI tool together (Bing Image Creator, Google Lens, Google Translate camera mode).
- Set healthy boundaries on AI use — it is a tool, not entertainment.
- Discuss AI news at dinner: "I saw AI in the news today — what do you think?"
- Encourage reading: Share articles about AI innovations and concerns.
